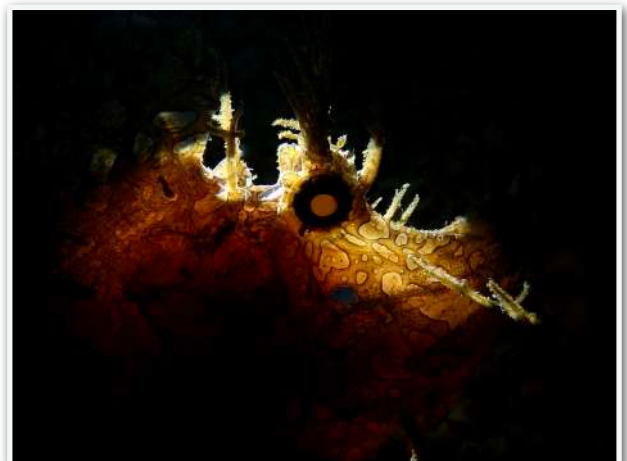

Not included in the standard diving rates:

- Equipment rental

On top of the above mentioned, for all PADI courses the following is included:

- Equipment rental during the course
- Logbook
- PADI materials: online e-Learning is included in the course price, if the client purchased these materials beforehand the costs will be deducted from the course price.



Infrastructure Tax

Starting from 1st July, 2023 all guests will be charged a new infrastructure tax imposed by the Zanzibar Revenue Board of US\$ 2 or its equivalent in Tanzania Shillings for 3 stars hotels per person per day from all guests both children and adults.

This mandatory infrastructure tax is not included in our price and will be paid directly at the Afro Divers Lodge together with other extras upon guest departure.

NEW: Mandatory Travel Insurance Now Required for All Tourists in Zanzibar

In a new twist aimed at making tourists feel safer, Zanzibar is set to introduce a comprehensive insurance scheme for all incoming travelers starting from the 1st of October this year. Up to a three-month insurance policy, costing 44 US\$ will be mandatory for inbound tourists arriving only in the Zanzibar archipelago and claims to provide immediate support in case of medical and other emergency situations.

How to Apply for Zanzibar's Mandatory Insurance

The procedure should be simple: visit the official Zanzibar tourism website <https://visitzanzibar.go.tz/>

Fill out your details, and pay the 44 US\$ fee (children 17-3 years for 22 US\$ and younger for free). The coverage applies to one person and only within the Zanzibar archipelago. Once the insurance and payment have been processed, you should receive a receipt with a QR code to present on arrival at immigration at the Zanzibar airport along with your tourist visas. The option to buy single insurance for the whole family or group should also be available in the future.

Travelers who arrive through a travel agent or other third party and have Zanzibar included in their itinerary should check whether the travel agent will arrange this compulsory insurance for them or whether they need to arrange it themselves. Arriving visitors without mandatory travel insurance may be denied entrance to Zanzibar. Insurance will also be available to purchase directly at the airport, however ZIC urges all arrivals to purchase insurance in advance to avoid queues forming and ensure a smooth passage through immigration.

Weather and diving conditions according to each month.

June: Occasional rains and winds, cooler nights, low touristic period. A good period for experienced divers.

July: This is the windiest month of the year. Thankfully we are better protected on the West Coast. Even though we experience many waves the underwater conditions are still good.

August: The ocean gets a lot calmer but also colder. This is probably the coldest month to dive with the water temperature as low as 23 degrees Celsius. Don't worry, we have enough neoprene to keep you warm.

September: September looks a lot like August but with no tourists which makes September a great month to visit. This is the middle of the Humpback Whale Season.

October and November: These months are getting warmer and the ocean is packed with fish. There is the small raining season which seems bad but actually the underwater conditions are excellent during the rains and often big pelagic fish are spotted!

December: December is one of the best months to visit, especially before the Christmas holidays. Above- as well as underwater we get excellent conditions.

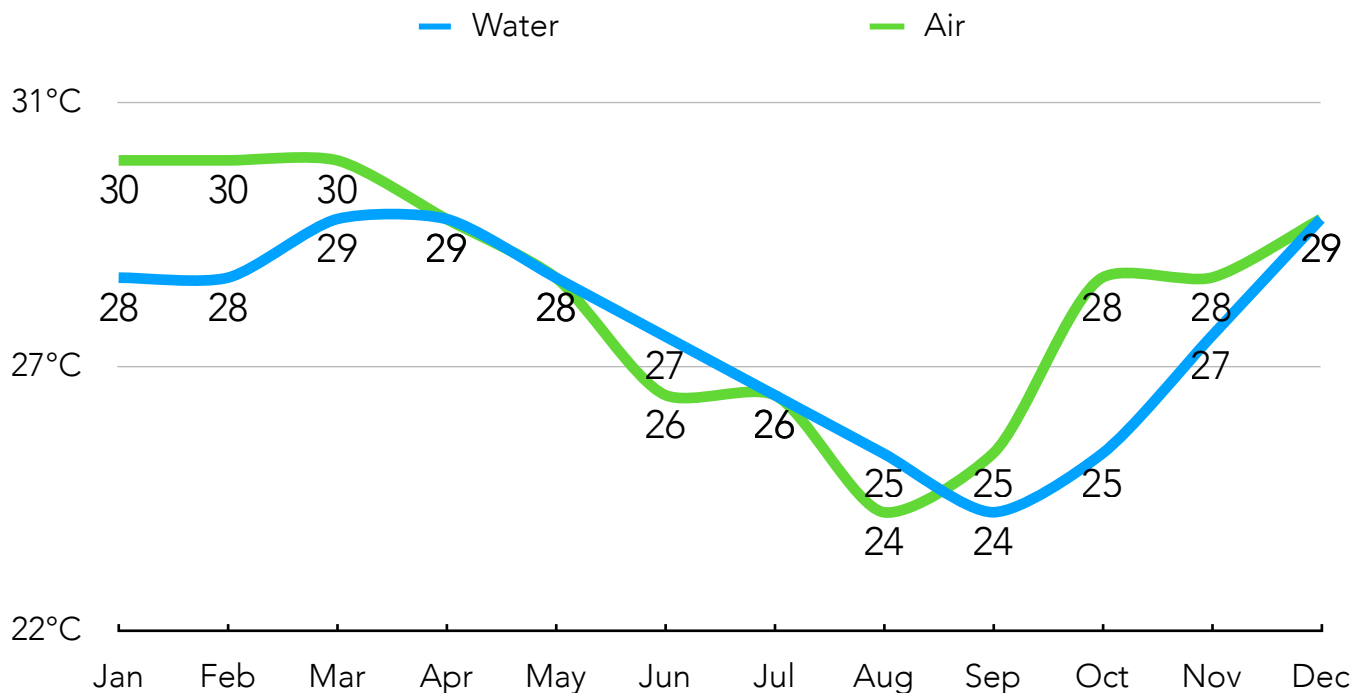
January and February: This is considered the high season due to the fact many Europeans try to flee from the cold. The weather is great and waters are warm, however there are occasionally strong North winds that can cause a bumpy boat ride.

March: March is our favorite month as the ocean becomes wind-still and we can practically dive wherever we want. Also there are few tourists so you should definitely have look to come in this period. Officially the raining season starts on the 22nd of March, however there is a big chance of good weather even after this date.

April: April is the low season but often the weather is beautiful in between occasional rains. At the end of the month we close our doors and resume in June.

May: May is still warm, big rain falls. Even in May there is a chance for good weather, therefore we remain open and give out great low-season discounts.

Minimum Stay

While there is no minimum stay during low, high and shoulder season, a minimum stay of 4 consecutive nights is required for any bookings / stays over peak period from 20/12/2024 up and including 09/01/2025.

Tanzanian Residents Discounts

Tanzanian Residents or East Africa Residents get a 10% discount on all accommodations, diving, and therefore dive-and stay packages.

East Africa includes: Burundi, Rwanda, Congo, Uganda, Kenia, Ethiopia, Somalia and South-Sudan.

Traveling to Pemba

The most convenient way to travel to Pemba Island by air. It takes you around 30 minutes on a domestic flight from Zanzibar and about one hour from Dar es Salam. There are multiple flights available every day.

Pemba Airport is a small regional airport and one of two airports that service the Zanzibar Archipelago in the Republic of Tanzania.

The following airlines are currently operating on daily basis to PMA airport. Afro Divers Lodge regularly books flights for its guests, but this can also be done directly:

The ferry service by AZAM is departing from Zanzibar/ Stone town to to Mkoani sea port in the southeast of Pemba Island (from there it is a 2 hours' drive to the Afro Divers Lodge).

A fast ferry service by FAST ZAN is also available from Zanzibar/ Stone town to Pemba Island/ Wete. Wete is closer to Afro Divers Lodge.

Passport & Visa

If you are visiting Tanzania, your passport should be valid for 6 months from the date of arrival. Most foreign passport holders need a tourist visa to enter Tanzania. Visa can be obtained on arrival or as an electronic Visa in advance.

Airport Transfer

On arrival to Pemba Airport guests will be picked up for a 1.5 hour drive through the island to Afro Divers Lodge and this is a very interesting drive in its own right.

On Departure guests will leave the resort 2.5 hours prior to their scheduled flight departure time.

Food & Beverage

NOTE: Pemba is a natural island but limited in its access to products. When staying with us please inform us if you have any dietary needs. Some items are brought in by plane or ferry therefore we want to be well prepared.

Enjoy the restaurant and bar of Afro Divers Lodge throughout your stay. As of our small scaled operation we offer carte d'hôte basis, offering a handful of choices per meal. You can expect whatever is served is fresh and made on the spot. We are mainly using local ingredients found on the islands. The Zanzibar Archipelago is famous for its spices, Swahili food is historically a mix of African, Indian and Arabic flavors. Fresh fish and sea fruit can be delivered on daily basis.

Our restaurant typically offers a menu of locally sourced ingredients and dishes inspired by the diverse cultures and cuisines of the Zanzibari region, including influences from the Mediterranean, Africa, and the Middle East.

Breakfast 07:00 - 09:00

Afro Divers Lodge breakfast will consist of a small but high quality buffet. Warm dishes can be ordered from the breakfast menu. The menu consist of salty and sweet dishes.

Lunch 11:00 - 15:00

Lunch will consist of starter, main course and desert, all having two or three choices, varying from local dishes to full fish platter or something simple such as burger, samosa's.

Dinner 19:00 - 21:30

After an eye awing sunset the sky in Pemba becomes pitch dark, with hopefully a lot of stars in the sky. Enjoy half board and treat yourself with a full course dinner! During your stay with us we will do our uttermost best to surprise you every single night.

Bar Happy Hour 18:00 - 19:00

Afro Divers Lodge is a special place visited by few, therefore sharing your moments at the lodge or underwater is often celebrated with some cold beers and fresh cocktails. Due to the remoteness of Pemba there the drink menu isn't as extended as you can find in mainstream areas but thanks to our access of amazing fruits we always have our cocktail of the day.

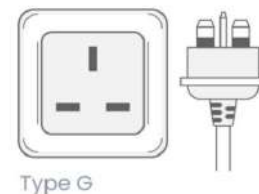


Free Internet

All our premises is covered with free Wi-Fi. For Tanzanian standard the speed is rather fast and it is possible to work remotely, receiving video calls and downloading files.

Mobile Network

The best and only network provider in our village is TIGO, formerly known as ZANTEL.



Electricity

The standard voltage of electricity supplied in Pemba is 230 V at a frequency of 50Hz.,

We have a back up generator in case of power cuts, something very common and frequent in Tanzania. There will be a minute to maximum three minutes pause between the power cut and the generator being started up.

The power swings a lot, this can damage electrical equipment. Therefore Afro Divers Lodge has a 60 KVA stabilizer to prevent equipments from damaging.

Power sockets in the Afro Divers Lodge are type D (three rectangular pins). Additional adaptors may be available on request from the Afro Divers Lodge Housekeeping Team or at the reception.

Water Supply

Since 2023 the water pressure in Makangale village has been outstanding. However water supply cuts are common due to ongoing maintenance, therefore Afro Divers Lodge has a 18.000 liters of water storage on site.

Currency & Payment

The Tanzanian Shilling (TZS) is the local currency of Pemba and the rest of Tanzania and is not available internationally. All Afro Divers Lodge services will be invoiced in US dollars.

For Payment at the Afro Divers Lodge, the following currencies for cash payment will be accepted, using the daily official exchange rate:

- US Dollar
- Tanzanian Shilling

Credit Card* payments will be charged through our local bank (PesaPal) with 3.75% surcharge.

Laundry Service

The Afro Divers Lodge offers an in-hotel laundry service for its guests. Laundry bags and laundry forms are provided in the villa for guests to leave their items. We recommend avoiding including high value and sensitive items in the laundry service.

Beach and Swimming Pool

Afro Divers Lodge is on a coast line with a lot of smaller and bigger white sand beaches. Our beach is rather small. In the months from June to November the beach is limited to only 30 meters wide. In the warmer months the winds change and the beach get increasingly bigger up to a 50 meters wide, beautiful white sand beach.

The tides in Pemba are really severe, with some days four meters difference between low- and high. Per day it is two times high and tow times low. With high tide it is ideal to swim, so for the other half of the day it isn't.

During low tide the sea weed farms are visibly and many local people come to the coast to harvest and maintain the aquaculture.

For Beach walks we recommend our guests to take some reefs shoes from the diving center, free of charge.

The pool is accessible the whole day. It can also be used for dive training.

Afro Divers Lodge beach is not the best beach in the area, especially during low tide. However we do organize on daily basis excursions the the sand bank and other remote beaches in Pemba.



Medical Plan

Due to the experience in scuba diving, Afro Divers Lodge is well prepared for medical emergencies for divers and non-divers. A couple of measures are set for the effectiveness of medical emergency management:

- 30% of all Afro Divers Lodge staff available are officially medically trained
- 100% of all Afro Divers Lodge staff is trained to follow emergency protocols.
- Extensive emergency evacuation plan for severe medical conditions.
- Extensive primary care plan
- Extensive Secondary Care plan
- Medical equipment such as, first aid kits, medical oxygen and secondary care items

Afro Divers Lodge Insurance

Afro Divers Lodge has an active insurance cover. Insurance coverage directly related to guests are:

- Theft and burglary insurance for any clients diving or staying at the Afro Divers Lodge
- Public Liability insurance for any accidents to Afro Divers Lodge or its staff is involved in.

Individuals Insurance

Afro Divers Lodge strongly advises its guests and customers to have an active travel insurance. For scuba divers it is important to have a travel insurance that includes scuba diving activities and particulate covers medical expenses such as 'recompression- or hyperbaric chamber expenses. These expenses as well as air medical evacuation are costly and worth having an insurance for.

Our Rooms

The rooms are typically situated 80 meters from the beachfront overlooking the ocean's horizon.

The top rooms provide breathtaking panoramic views of the sea, while the ground floor rooms offer a 15-meter front garden for each room, giving an amazing privacy on the terrace.

The rooms overlook two immense baobab trees, only a few high-end resorts in Tanzania are able to offer that.

The rooms are designed with modern amenities and luxury furnishings, including king-size beds, spacious living areas, private outdoor spaces, and a spacious en-suite bathroom.



All rooms are designed with an open front view, thanks to the stylish, steel-framed folding doors. The doors open entirely, creating a stunning view from the inside of the room, while laying on your bed. From the terrace all the way to the showers plants are placed, creating a **botanic interior and exterior**.

Privacy is one of our core values for the rooms. The construction has been built with the strongest materials found in Tanzania with 7" walls between the rooms we assure to be soundproof.

The Afro Divers Lodge only consists of 10 rooms, which is considered very small in the region. Staying here is a very personal experience and our team will make sure we serve your needs as detailed as possible. If you are not a diver you will be equally satisfied with your experience with us.

Standard Room

Our eight Standard Rooms are consisting of the following:

- 30 meters square living space
- 10 meters square outside terrace
- 10 meters square en-suite bathroom
- Air-conditioning, ceiling fan and bed fan
- Tea and coffee station
- Extra bed available



Superior Room

Our two Superior Rooms are consisting of the following:

- 40 meters square living space
- 10 meters square outside terrace
- 10 meters square en-suite bathroom
- Air-conditioning, ceiling fan and bed fan
- Tea and coffee station
- 2 Extra beds available

First room interior pictures will be expected to be ready November 2024.

PADI Courses

All Courses are conducted within the PADI guidelines. Afro Divers offers thorough dive training, when one extra need to be added for the course will be free of charge.

Minimum ages for PADI diving courses

For the youngest diver the 'PADI Junior Open Water Course' can be conducted from an age of 10 years old.

The 'PADI Bubblemaker Course' allows children to start diving from 8 years old. Please enquire for availability.

PADI e-Learning

PADI eLearning is included in the above mentioned prices. US\$ 90,- will be deducted when eLearning has already been purchased.

Additional diving after a course

The total amount of days of open water diving will be deducted from the amount of days in the open water conducting the course.

Scuba Cylinders

Afro Divers has aluminum cylinders of 11.1 Liters, or 80 cubic feet. We also have smaller 7 Liters, or 80 cubic feet, for technical dives or for children. **We offer Nitrox, usually enriched to 31%.**

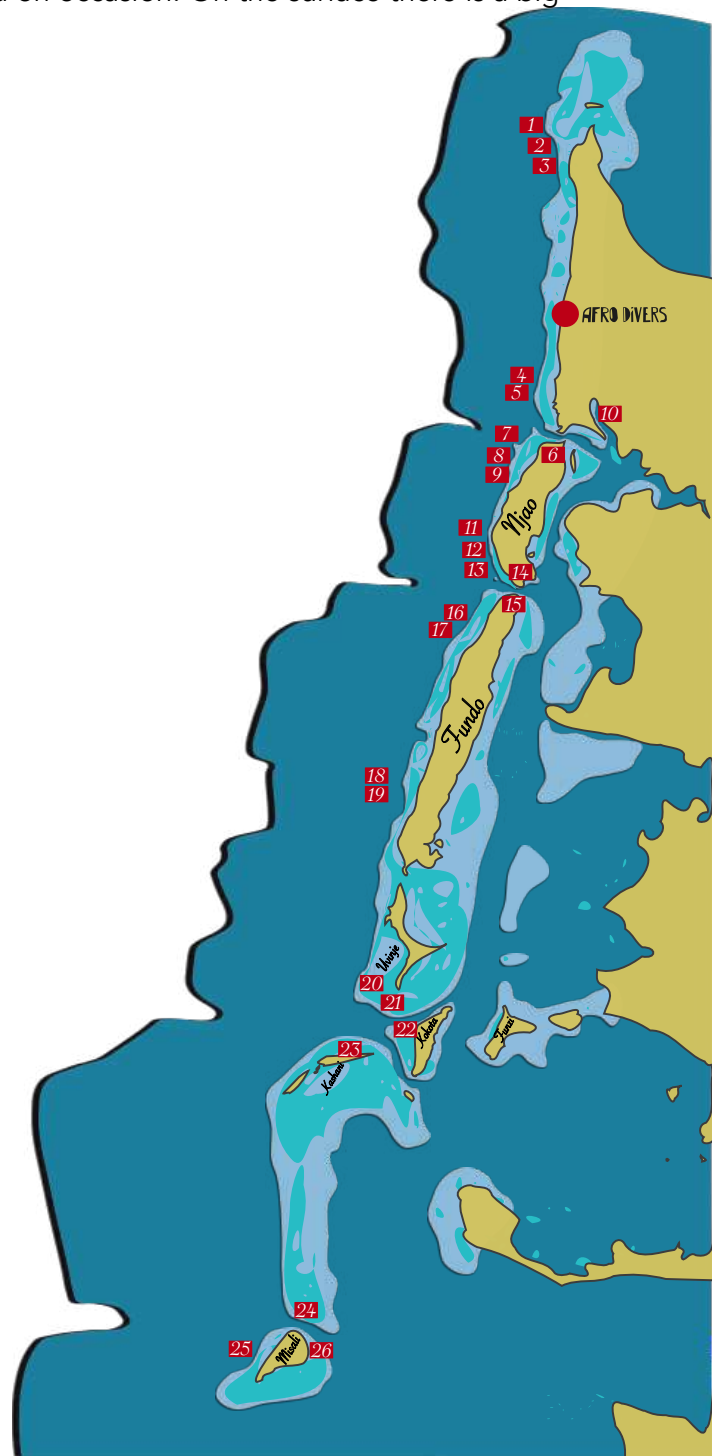
Dive Sites of Afro Divers

Diving around Pemba is exciting thanks to its deep and crystal clear waters. Most of our dive sites are dramatic walls that drop off from 12m down to 50m and below. On Pemba, the aquatic fauna & flora are rich, healthy and well preserved.

The Diversity of corals and sponges on these dive sites is truly unique. There are big populations of reef fish in all different colors and shapes, Turtles, giant Napoleon wrasses, Rays, Barracudas...

In the current you find big school of pelagic fishes such as Tunas, Rainbow Runners, Trevallies, king fish...

Reef Sharks, whales and whales sharks can be spotted on occasion. On the surface there is a big chance of seeing schools of dolphins



Big fish

The Afro Divers team has been making thousands of dives over the years on the reefs in Pemba. We often come around big surprises such as rays, big groupers and giant trevallies. When lucky whale sharks, thresher sharks, hammerhead sharks and other reef sharks can be spotted.

More common sharks are white tip reef sharks which we can find on dive sites like the Aquarium, Mandela Wall, Groupers Den and Shimba Hills.

Some channel dive sites with medium to sturgeon incoming currents are ideal for big pelagic fish, however conditions need to be ideal and divers need to be able to conduct these dives.

Corals and Sponges

Pemba is the best place in East Africa for corals and sponges. Dive sites are endless, just a continuation of corals, as well as a very high diversity of species.

Emillio's Backpassage, Bikini Wall have the most mind-blowing sponge growth you will ever see in your 'dive-life'; walls covered in different species of sponges.

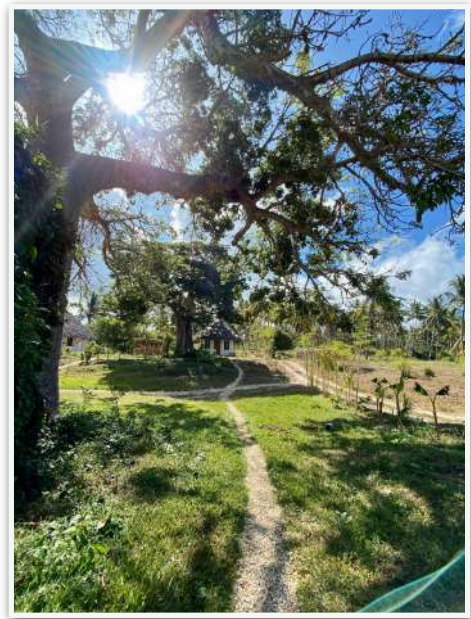
Pemba had some coral degradation in March 2024 due to the El Niño, causing many corals to bleach and eventually die. Luckily many corals have survived a most of the dive sites have remained very rich and colorful.

Macro

Pemba is a very good destination for macro. We have the classic species of nudibranchs, tiny shrimps, frog fish and also more rare species.

We like to dive with the macro photographers in mangrove estuaries for finding special species as well as quietness to really focus on making the perfect shot.

Cancellation Policy

This cancellation policy is applied to the following bookings:

- Pre-booked diving packages
- Pre-booked Dive&Stay Packages
- Pre-booked Dive&Stay Packages with third parties such as hotels and safari companies.

1. 10% cancellation fee if canceled more than 90 days before tour start;
2. 30% cancellation fee if canceled 60-89 days before tour start;
3. 60% cancellation fee if canceled 30-59 days before tour start;
4. 80% cancellation fee if canceled 8-29 days before tour start;
5. No refund if canceled 0-7 days before tour start.

This cancellation policy does not apply to the following products. The following products are non-refundable:

- Domestic flight tickets
- PADI materials such as eLearning for courses

Payments

In order to avoid high bank fees, Afro Divers and Afro Dives Lodge recommend the following payments with best options first:
