Mangroves are dense, tangled forests of trees and shrubs that thrive in shallow, brackish water along coastlines and in estuaries. These forests provide important habitats for a variety of marine life, including fish, crabs and birds (such as herons, egrets and kingfishers). You can observe the mangrove trees' unique structure, with their characteristic roots extending above the waterline to provide a vital habitat for various marine species. Diving or snorkelling in the mangrove is very much recommended. This is where you can find the most amazing, finest and rarest Pemba critters (the perfect place for macro lovers!). With an experienced local guide on hand to provide insights and opportunities for fishing and wildlife observation, this tour offers guests a deeper appreciation of the natural world and its intricate connections.

Birds watching

The island is a unique area for birdwatchers due to its isolation, which has resulted in these species
